Brief course description	<p>The aim of the course is to acquaint the students with a very important and specific area of the EU, the European administrative procedure, which has an impact on national administrative procedural law. Particular emphasis is placed on the specifics of the implementation of specific administrative procedures (in various areas such as environmental protection, state aid, competition, etc.) and the analysis of selected administrative, administrative-judicial practice, EU courts and the ECHR.</p> <p>The objective of the course is to highlight the importance of the procedural rights of the parties and the principles of administrative procedures at national and European level, in particular the right to good administration and the principles of procedural effectiveness and equivalent legal protection. Issues such as administrative cooperation and national procedural autonomy and the relationship between national and European administrative procedural law and the impact of the Europeanization and harmonization process on the Croatian administrative procedure will also be highlighted. To emphasize the importance of comparative examples in the field of European administrative procedures (France, Germany, Slovenia, Italy, Poland, etc.) and the adoption of best practice and European standards of procedure.</p> <p>The aim is that after completing the course students can compare national and European administrative procedures and highlight similarities and differences.</p>
