Course title	SOCIAL CARE SYSTEM AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

Brief course description	The aim of the course is to acquaint the students with Croatian social care system. Main social welfare principles, financing aspects, service providers and beneficiaries will be considered in current context. The focus will be at the rights and services prescribed by the Social Welfare Act. Their specifics will be discussed and compared to examples of different countries.  The key institutional role have Social Care Centers as legal entities with public authority (public administrative authority/bodies) which according to General Administrative Procedure Act (GAPA) conduct administrative procedures and resolve in administrative matters. GAPA regulates general administrative procedures, while special administrative fields of social welfare rights and services are regulated by a number of special laws such as Social welfare Law, Interim Maintenance Act, Family Law, etc. Emphasis will be put on the resolving individual and concrete administrative matters/cases and legal protection of procedural rights and standards in the special administrative fields and procedures-social welfare (analyses of decisions of the selected Social Care Centers and decisions in the appeal procedure in front of Ministry of Demographics, Family, Youth and Social Policy).  After completion of the course, students could compare Croatian and foreign social care systems and administrative procedures.
