<i>1.1. Course objectives</i>		
<p>The cornerstone of legal unification in general, but specifically in EU in the last few decades lies with the free circulation of a judgements. As legal rights more often need to be enforced outside the jurisdiction that has issued a judgement, EU is building a legal system upon the mutual trust doctrine. The course would be based on general legal theory and problems inherent to private international law aspects in Cross-Border civil Procedure. The course would address the EU legislation and CJEU case law, as well as HCCH Judgments Convention the EU has acceded.</p>
