

pre-Bologna legal regulations, have completed specialist studies or have already enrolled postgraduate doctoral studies in the field of legal science or other social sciences at other faculties in Croatia or abroad. While enrolling the stated candidates in the Doctoral Study Programme of Law, the Council of

the Studies, or special committee empowered by the Council shall, in accordance with regulations and enactments of the University, for every single candidate determine under which conditions and in which semester they can be enrolled, taking into consideration their prior learning and the curricula of their prior studies, as well as which exams can be recognized in the process of enrolling in the Postgraduate Study Programme of Law.

All candidates listed under a), b) and c) will pass an additional check of motivation related to the intended area of research in the doctoral study and the scientific justification of the proposed research.

Appointment of Mentors

Doctoral study programme

In the enrolment procedure in the Doctoral Study Programme the Council of the Studies makes decision on the formal appointment of a mentor, the topic of the doctoral dissertation and the acceptance of an individual research plan.

The mentor is obliged to conscientiously, competently and ethically and scientifically responsibly take care of the doctoral student to whom he / she has been appointed as a mentor.

The mentor helps the doctoral student during the doctoral study and is obliged to guide and guide him in scientific work and application of scientific methods during the preparation of the doctoral dissertation, monitor the quality of his work, encourage him to publish papers and enable him to participate in scientific projects.

The mentor is obliged to check the authenticity of each written work of the doctoral student.

The mentor verifies the fulfillment of elective study obligations on the prescribed form, according to the criteria determined by the Doctoral Study Council (16 ECTS credits per each academic year).

The mentor is obliged to submit a report once a year on the work of the doctoral student and his / her progress during the doctoral study.

In addition to the mentor of the doctoral dissertation, the student can also be assigned a co-mentor who, together with the mentor, monitors the candidate in his doctoral research because of the inter- disiplinarity of the research or because the mentor is from abroad or from another collaborating in- stitution. Co--mentor can be a person elected to scientific-educational position (Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, Full Professor) or a scientist elected to a scientific position (scientific associate, senior scientific associate or scientific adviser).

Structure and organisation of the doctoral study programme

The Doctoral Study Programme of Law lasts for 3 years or 6 semesters.

It is completed by defending a doctoral dissertation, upon which the doctoral candidate is awarded the degree of the Doctor of Science (PhD /dr. sc.).

Total number of ECTS credits attained during the Doctoral Studies is 180, which are distributed in 60 ECTS per year.

Apart from two methodological compulsory courses and elective courses, research seminars and research papers are introduced in accordance with personal interests of the candidates.

Within this structure, candidates are offered flexibility in their choice of study contents and in development of their individual academic profile.

Enrolment Conditions

Studies can be enrolled by candidates who

a) have completed the Integrated University Undergraduate and Graduate Study Programme of Law or the pre-Bologna four-year-graduate study programme of law (under the condition that they have enclosed a certificate or diploma on equalizing the obtained academic title in accordance with the applicable legal regulations), and have earned 300 ECTS credits during their previous education, with an grade point average 3.5 or higher. Exceptionally, the Study Programme can be enrolled by the candidates who have completed their previous level of education by earning a lower average grade (not less than 3.0), if they enclose obligatory recommendations of at least two professors and/or scientists from the corresponding scientific areas included in the Doctoral Study Programme:

b) have completed the Graduate Study Programme or the pre-Bologna four-year-graduate study programmes in the scientific area of social sciences (economics, politology and others) and have previously earned 300 ECTS credits with the grade point average 3.5 or higher. Exceptionally, the Study Programme can be enrolled by the candidates who have completed their previous level of education by earning a lower average grade (not less than 3.0), if they enclose obligatory recommendations of at least two professors and/ or scientists from the corresponding scientific areas included in the Doctoral Study Programme. In the enrolment procedure, the Council of the Doctoral Study Programme (respectively the committee empowered by the Council), shall determine course exams within the Integrated Undergraduate and Graduate Study Programme of Law that the candidate is obliged to pass, but the workload should not exceed 30 ECTS.

c) have completed postgraduate scientific (magister) studies in legal sciences or postgraduate scientific (magister) studies in other social sciences under the
