### RESULTS

- Development of joint and multidisciplinary E-Module on Refugee and Migration Oriented Education (with 3 sub-modules)
- Preparation and delivery of two intensive programmes in Lithuania (March 2018) and Croatia (March 2019) to test E-learning tool
- Official recognition of E-learning platform for Module on Refugee and Migration Oriented Education into the formal curriculum of all five Law Schools (ECTS points).

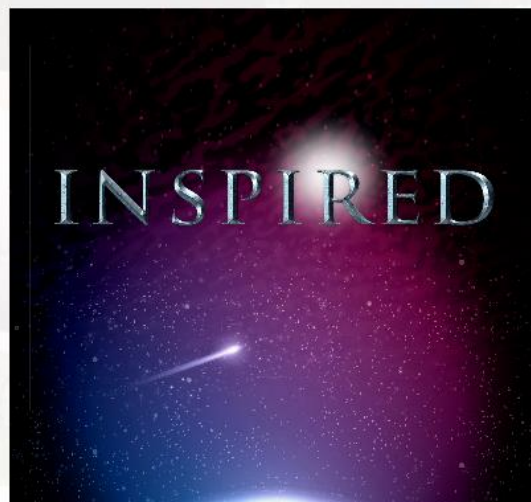
