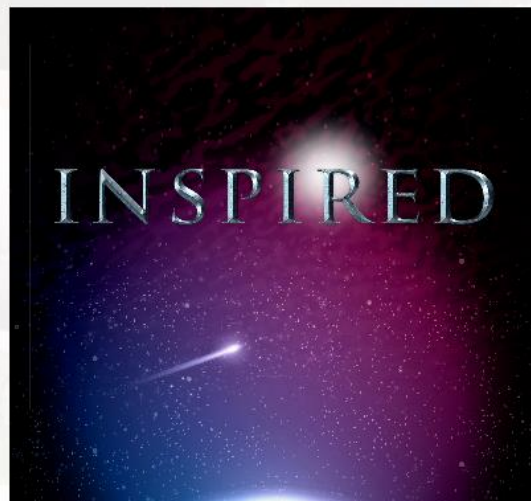

Projekt "INSPIRED – Innovative Solutions for Practicality and Impact in Refugee and Migration Oriented Education" je međunarodni projekt koji se provodi u strateškom partnerstvu pet europskih pravnih fakulteta: Pravni fakultet Osijek Sveučilišta Josipa Jurja Strossmayera u Osijeku (koordinator projekta), Pravni fakultet Sveučilišta Mykolas Romeris iz Litve, Pravni fakultet Inholland Sveučilišta za primjenjene znanosti iz Nizozemske, Pravni fakultet Sveučilišta u Pečuhu iz Mađarske te Pravni fakultet Sveučilišta London South Bank iz Ujedinjenog Kraljevstva. Sveučilište Ulster iz Ujedinjenog kraljevstva je pridruženi partner.

Glavne projektne aktivnosti su: razvoj zajedničkog i multidisciplinarnog e-modula o izbjegličkom i migracijom pravu (sa 3 pod-modula) koji će se u ožujku 2018. testirati u Litvi, a u godinu dana kasnije (ožujak 2019.) i završno predstaviti u Hrvatskoj. Osim testiranja i uvođenja novog zajedničkog modula, tijekom provedbe projekta predviđen i čitav niz drugih popratnih aktivnosti.

Projekt je nastao kao potreba projektnih partnera za provođenjem programa koji bi obuhvatili i omogućili specijalizaciju studenata u području EU prava koje je, s obzirom na novije događaje u Europi i šire, jedno od najaktualnih pitanja u Europskoj uniji, a to je pitanje izbjeglica i migracija, s naglaskom na temeljna prava, zaštitu žrtava trgovine ljudima i mjere EU protiv organiziranog kriminala i terorizma.

Projekt je sufinanciran sredstvima Europske unije kroz program Erasmus+, a provodi se od 1. listopada 2017. do 30. rujna 2019. godine.

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INSPIRED Joint and multidisciplinary E-Module on Refugee and Migration Oriented Education

Joint E-Module consists of 3 Sub-modules: (a) European Dimension of Freedom, (b) Migration and Refugee Law; (c) Justice and Security. The aim of Joint E-Module is to improve the quality and relevance of legal education in the field of refugee and migration law at five European Faculties of Law (Croatia, Hungary, Lithuania, the Netherlands and the UK). Creation of international specialized learning module that incorporates new methods of teaching in existing legal education was one of the goals of the project. Another goal was to harmonize legal education in five universities through a joint curriculum enabling further cooperation in joint programs among partner universities, enabling synergies and cross-fertilization of traditional legal education. INSPIRED introduced innovative learning methods in legal education such as virtual mobility, strategic use of Information and Communication Technologies and use of open educational resources.

C 3 Intensive Program Access2justice4 refugees September 2019 Lithuania

IP provided knowledge and skills to participants on refugee rights, refugee law and technologies that could be developed and used to enhance refugee access to rights in the host country. Program included 24 students and 11 teachers from 3 Universities. Students learned: a) about practical legal problems that refugees encounter in partner countries; b) how technology could be used to solve legal problems and enhance refugee access to rights and justice. Students were introduced to mobile app development, chat-bots powered by AI and gamification principles and technologies. Students had intensive workshops, where they created useful technological tools for refugees. The outputs of the IP were: 1) creation of mobile apps for refugees that could serve as a tool for delivering relevant legal and practical information to refugees about the partner countries 2) creation of a chatbot for advising refugees on most pertinent questions related to their rights in the host country.

Poster presentation of project INSPIRED

Poster presentation of project INSPIRED was used throughout the project to increase visibility of EC funding and to promote project activities, results, objectives and impact. Poster presentation was very instrumental at various national and international conferences where INSPIRED project staff were presenting project using the poster. INSPIRED poster presentation was also used during Night of Researchers in Osijek, Croatia and Festival of Science at University of Osijek, Croatia to disseminate project results and promote all activities, including creation of e-module, publication of joint teachers' papers and publication of students' papers.

INSPIRED Press and Social Media Coverage

Project INSPIRED was widely covered by local press and media in all five partner countries (Lithuania, Croatia, UK, Holland, Hungary). C1 Intensive Program March 2018 Lithuania

Intensive programs were delivered in two parts: Part I (two sub-modules on European Dimension of Freedom and Migration and Refugee Law) were tested in e-learning form during intensive program in March 2018 in Vilnius. 89 students and 13 teachers from 6 Universities participated in first IP, selected using the same criteria, established by the Strategic Partnership Consortium. Particular attention was given to the inclusion of disadvantaged students and students with reduced mobility. The testing week in March 2018 focused on face-to face learning of participants and relied on materials, tools and interactive exercises available on e-learning platform that will have to be completed before the IP. This included materials developed for the Module, but also modern ICT

in Rotterdam, Holland in February 2018, the third in June 2018 in London, UK, fourth in November 2018 in Belfast, UK, fifth in ... meeting in June 2019 in Vilnius, Lithuania.

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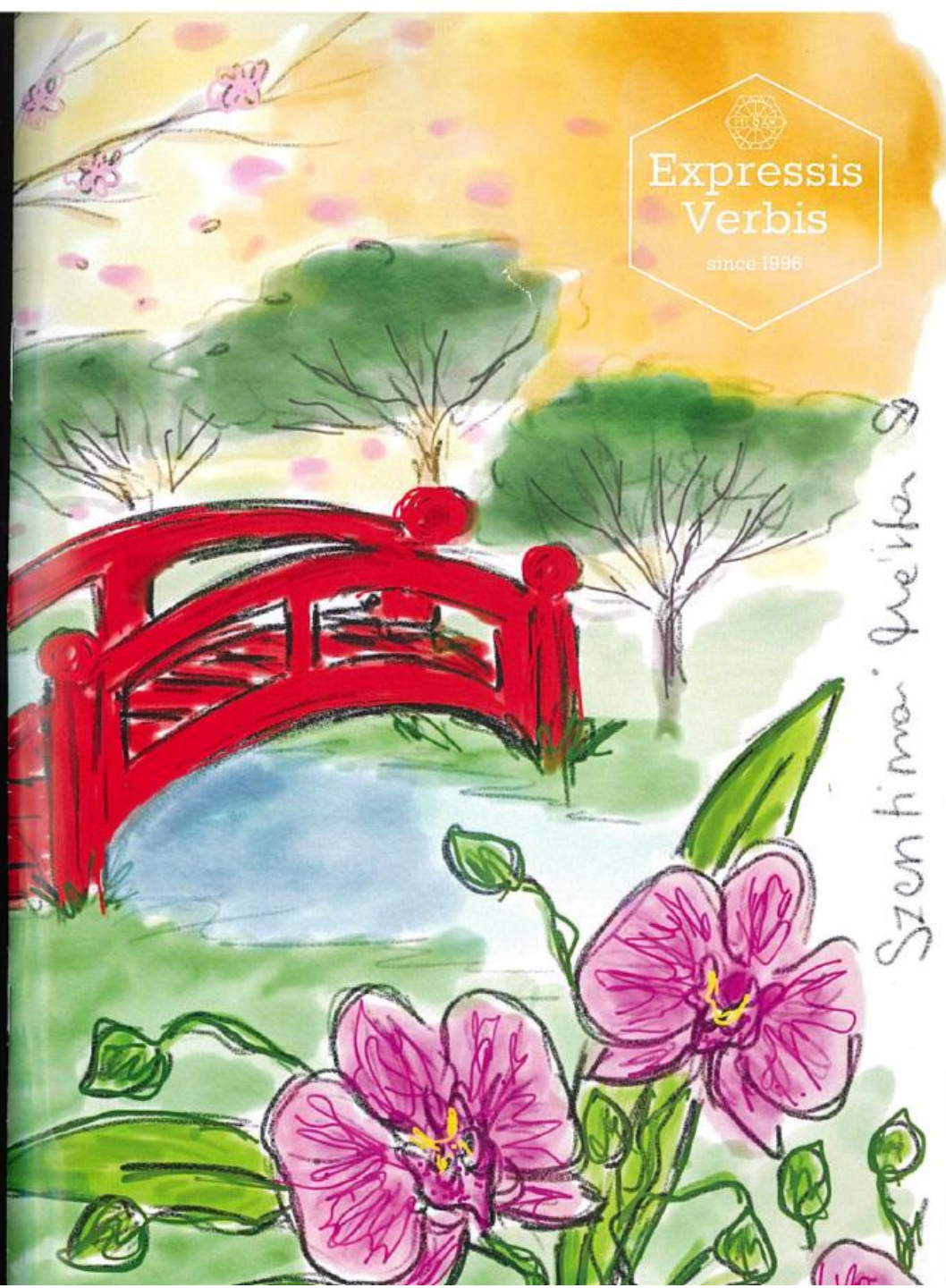


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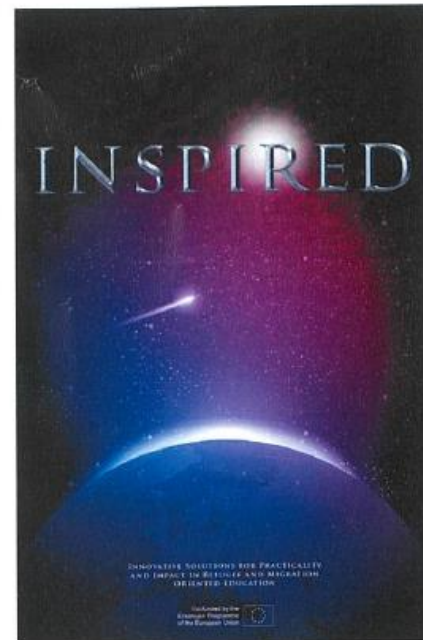
INSPIRED 2019 Opatija

Students from Croatia, UK, LT Met to Seek Solutions to Aid Refugees



Sept. 16th-20th, 2019, students from Croatia, the United Kingdom and Lithuania met at Mykolas Romeris University (MRU) where they took part in an intensive studies programme, "Access_to_justice4refugees."

They worked in teams to seek solutions to help refugees. Artificial intelligence, discussion robots, and applications will be used to bring law more closer to students and understandable to society's most vulnerable - refugees and their children.

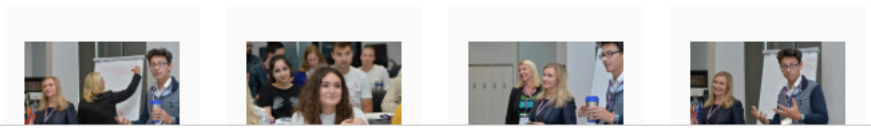
Academics and professors from London's South Bank University, Croatia's Josip Juraj Strossmayer Osijek University and MRU not only presented lectures about refugee law and its problems, but also in practical workshops helped students to create innovative solutions to problems.

The programme is part of the project, INSPIRED – Innovative Solutions for Practicality and Impact in Refugee and Migration Oriented Education" and is implemented by 6 Law Faculties: Croatia's Josip Juraj Strossmayer University of Osijek (project coordinator), Hungary's Pecs University, Netherland's Haag Inholland University of Applied Sciences, London's „South Bank" University; Northern Ireland's Ulster University and Mykolas Romeris University (MRU).

The main goal of the project is to create a joint, interdisciplinary learning module about refugees and migration law.

Mykolas Romeris Law School Legaltech Centre Head Dr. Martynas Mockus said the project, INSPIRED, is unique because it unites many different students, from different countries in the name of aiding refugees.

"Help comes in the form of using the latest technologies. A solid team of lecturers from 3 univesities will help students to implement their ideas in a short period of time, Mockus said.

Skirtingų šalių studentai kurs inovatyvius sprendimus pabėgėliams

Studentai iš Lietuvos, Jungtinės Karalystės ir Kroatijos dirbdami komandose kurs inovatyvius sprendimus, skirtus padėti pabėgėliams. Dirbtiniai intelektas, pokalbių robotai, įsaiybinimas ir aplikacijos bus panaudotos, siekiant priartinti teise, ją padaryti lengviau suprantamą vienai labiausiai pažeidžiamų visuomenės grupių – pabėgėliams ir ypač jų vaikams.

Rugpjūčio 16-20 d. Mykolo Romerio universitete vyks intensyvi studijų programa „Access_to_justice4refugees“. Susirinkę lektoriai, profesoriai iš Londono „South Bank“ universiteto, Kroatijos Josip Juraj Strossmayer Osijeko universiteto ir MRU ne tik dėstys studentams teorines ir praktines paskaitas apie pabėgėlių teises problemas, bet ir praktinėse dirbtuvėse padės studentams sukurti inovatyvius problemas sprendžiančius sprendimus, suteiks IT projektų planavimo ir valdymo žinių, tobulins projektų, idėjų pristatymo („pitchinimo“) įgūdžius.

MRU Teisės mokyklos Legaltech centro vadovas dr. Martynas Mockus sako, jog tai yra unikalus projektas, kuriame susitinka tiek daug skirtingų išsilavinimų, skirtingų valstybių studentai, verdam tiktai kilmus tikslu – padėti tiri pažeidžiamai visuomenės grupė – pabėgėliams. „Pagalba bus teikiama pasinaudojant naujausiomis technologijomis, o solidi lektorių komanda iš trijų universitetų padės studentams įgyvendinti savo idėjas per tiri trumpą, – sako M. Mockus. – Turime pokalbių robotų, semantinių technologijų, įsaiybinimo (angl. gamification), dirbtinio intelekto, apps'ų kūrimo specialistų, kurie bus pasirengę padėti studentams“.


Pasak pašnekovo, šioje projekte dalyvauja ir MRU socialinio darbo programą studijuojantis teisimo ekspertas pabėgėlių klausimams Graikijoje. „Jis yra sukaupęs įgimėtę ir neįkainojamą patirtį dirbdamas Graikijoje pabėgėlių stovyklose, mokantis pagrindines pabėgėlių vartojamas kalbas, matęs, kokie pažeidžiami yra pabėgėliai, kaip dėl informacijos neprieinamumo jiems kiesti nusikalstamas verslas, uždraustos veiklos“, – pastebi M. Mockus.

Projekte taip dalyvauja MRU studentai iš Baltarusijos, Kazachstano, Ukrainos, studijuojantis įvairias specialybes, pvz. e-verslą, psichologiją ir teise.

Law Students Attending Lectures in Croatia March 16th-22nd



March 16th-22nd, 2019, Mykolas Romeris University (MRU) Law students will be attending lectures in Opatija, Croatia's held in conjunction with Josip Juraj Strossmayer University of Osijek.

The Croatian university is coordinating the Innovative Solutions for Practicality and Impact in Refugee and Migration Oriented Education (INSPIRED) project, which is financing the lectures and workshops.

There are 21 MRU law students that are traveling to Croatia including those from France, Georgia and Ukraine. Students are enrolled in Bachelor's and Master's

Degree programmes.

Six different European universities are taking part in the project including MRU's Law School.

The other universities are: Inholland University of Applied Sciences (Den Haag, Netherlands); University of Pecs (Hungary); London South Bank University (United Kingdom); Northern Ireland's University of Ulster (Associate partner) and Croatia's Josip Juraj Strossmayer University of Osijek.

The project will result in a joint interdisciplinary learning module on refugee and migration law.

It aims to fill a need to implement a program allowing students to specialize in refugee and migration law. Given the recent events in Europe and elsewhere abroad, Refugee and Migration Law is one of the most current issues in the European Union. The main emphasis of sub-modules will be fundamental rights justice and security and refugee law.

This project is co-funded by the EU Erasmus+ Programme K2 Strategic Partnership in Higher Education programme and will be implemented from October 1st, 2017 to September 30th, 2019.

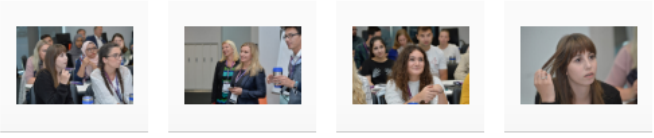
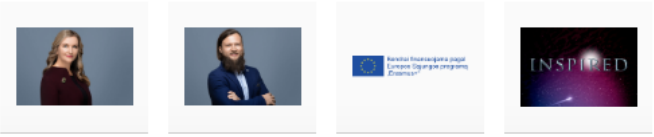

MRU Teisės mokyklos Legaltech centro vadovas dr. 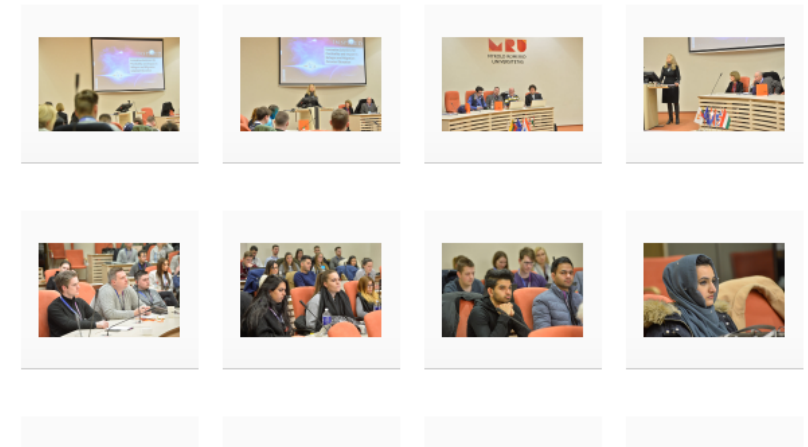

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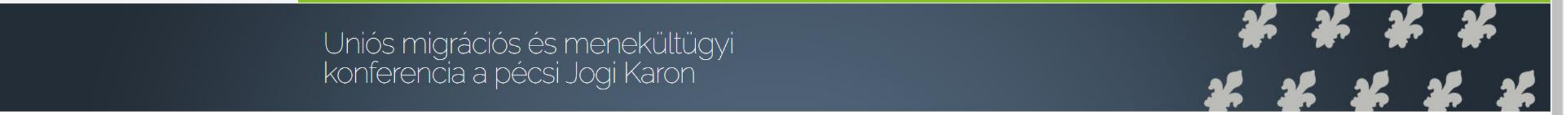
